  - ii. simplified processes for equipment maintenance by the broadcaster's trainees in order to maintain the equipment's good working condition
- iii. Programming basics and use of Community Radio Station for social, cultural, political and spiritual upliftment of people in the region
- iv. Two local engineers were involved all through the installation.(Grateful to MCIT, Ethiopia)
